

## **Holy Week Worship Schedule**

### Palm Sunday Service—April 2

In worship on Palm Sunday, we will celebrate Jesus' Triumphant Entry into Jerusalem. The Chancel Choir, children, youth and families will open the worship service with a choral introit, a poetic telling and reenactment of the first Palm Sunday. Everyone in the congregation will be given a small palm frond to wave in their pews as Jesus travels through the sanctuary on the back of a Donkey. Later in the service there will also be a time for children to come forward for a special lesson and be given a child's activity bag. The Chancel Choir will be presenting a powerful anthem "Open the Gates" and we will partake of Holy Communion.

### Tenebrae Ser ice - Thursday, April 6

On Thursday of Holy Week (**April 6**) we will be having our annual Maundy Thursday/Tenebrae worship service in the sanctuary at 7:00 pm. We will have Holy Communion as we remember Jesus' last supper with his disciples. Then we will have Holy Communion as we remember Jesus' last supper with his disciples. Then we will observe Tenebrae, the "Service of Darkness" that dates back to the early years of the Christian church and is considered the most solemn celebration of the church. Tenebrae (the Latin word for "shadows") depicts the approaching crucifixion, as people representing the deserting disciples read the various "shadows" from scripture and extinguish the Tenebrae candles one by one. The service concludes in silence, with the last candle, symbolizing Jesus, being carried from the church. This candle will remain lit until it is returned to the sanctuary on Easter morning, symbolizing Christ's resurrection from the dead.

### Easter Sunday - April 9

On Sunday, **April 9**, we will celebrate Christ's resurrection at our 9:30 am worship service in the sanctuary.

We look forward to having our Chancel Bells playing in worship, along with other special music for Easter! Christ has risen! He has risen indeed!

After worship we will have Coffee Fellowship in the Fellowship Hall. We look forward to seeing one another on this joyous occasion!



### Palm Sunday Breakfast - April 2

We will begin our celebration with fellowship at the Palm Sunday Breakfast beginning at 8:00 am. In order to know how many people plan to enjoy the meal of pancakes, eggs, sausage and fruit, tickets are being sold in advance. The cost is \$10 for adults and is free for children. If you have not yet purchased your ticket but plan to come, there will be one more opportunity to sign up in Fellowship Hall on March 26, or you may stop by the church office to buy the ticket.
