In the coming days, you will receive an envelope by mail outlining this survey, and shortly after an email with a unique link to the CAT. Beginning **October 20**, we are asking you to go online by clicking on the link provided and giving us feedback on your vision for the future of our church. Your opinions are highly valued. Don't worry if you are "technologically challenged." There will be volunteers with computers to help you complete the online survey after church service on Oct. 22, Oct. 29 and Nov. 5. We will need to have all responses completed by Nov. 10.

All answers are strictly anonymous. There is no way to match any assessment to a particular person, so please candidly give your opinions. Our future together is dependent on your participation and honest answers. Please do not discuss your responses with others as that may influence their answers. Be a Cool Cat!

World Communion Sunday – October 1



With Pastor Renée at Westminster Woods for the All-Church Retreat on October 1st, we will welcome the Rev. Jeff Kunkel to our pulpit. Jeff is a retired United Methodist pastor who, like Renée, specialized in interim ministry, and has served two Presbyterian churches in our Presbytery. He is also an artist and author of several books.

On this Sunday, Christians all around the world will be celebrating World Communion Sunday. This is a Sunday where we celebrate our oneness in Christ around the table with believers everywhere.

This is also the Sunday when we will receive the Peace and Global Witness Offering, which supports our partners in the Presbyterian Church as they continue their efforts to be a part of God's peacemaking and witness throughout the world. You may place your offering envelope in the offering box (in the narthex) before or after worship.

New Worship Series and Bible Study beginning on Sunday, October 8 Seven Marks of Vital Church Communities

The Holy Spirit's power is constantly reforming and revitalizing the Church. This worship and Bible Study series will use scripture to examine core qualities of churches. We will read, study, and discuss texts related to seven positive indicators (referred to as *marks of congregational vitality*) that communities of faith can possess. Along the way, we'll examine:

- 1. Lifelong Discipleship Formation (Acts 2:42-47)
- 2. Intentional Authentic Evangelism (John 4:1-41)
- 3. Outward Incarnational Focus (Romans 12:1-21)
- 4. Empower Servant Leadership (John 13:1-20)
- 5. Spirit-Inspired Worship (Isaiah 6:1-8)
- 6. Caring Relationships (Galatians 6:1-10)
- 7. Living a Wholehearted Faith (Mark 12:28-34)

We will be offering five weekly Bible Study and Discussion Groups so that participants can study and discuss the scriptures and topics deeper in a small group setting. The five groups will be offered one on Sunday and 4 on Wednesday at different times as well as in different locations, but all will cover the same material each week. This will allow participants to attend the group at the time and location that best fits their schedule each week. Some groups* will need to be limited in size as they will meet in private homes, so we ask that you please sign up on Sunday mornings in Fellowship Hall. 
